FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

“What curriculum does the Addison Park District Preschool follow?”

The Addison Park District Preschool follows the Illinois Early Learning and Development Standards. Please visit www.illinoisearlylearning.org for more details.

“When can I meet the teachers and find out what my child will be doing in preschool?”

We hold two open house events in March and in August or you can contact the Preschool Coordinator at 630-656-6208 for further details.

“When does school start?”

School starts on the Tuesday or Wednesday during Labor Day week, dependent on which session your child attends. Classes begin at 9:15am and end at 11:15am. The last days of school typically occur during mid May.

“What paperwork is necessary for entering the preschool program?”

-Proof of Residency, such as a utility bill, and birth certificates are required to register. All other forms are available at www.addisonparks.org under "Things to Do", "Preschool" or forms can be printed at the front desks at Centennial Club Fitness or Community Recreation Center.

-Information Sheet - Please provide the staff with all possible emergency numbers and information about any individual that is allowed to pick up your child from school.

-Immunization Record Sheet - This document is to be provided by your child's healthcare provider.

-Dispense of Medication Waiver - This form must be completed for the session and when there are medication changes.

-Inhaler/Auto-Injector Form - This waiver is to be signed as a waiver and release of all claims for use of inhaler or auto-injector.

“When is the paperwork due and where should I turn it in?”

Paperwork is due on the day of registration but must be turned in prior to the first day of class.

“What is the payment arrangement?”

Payment can be made in full at the time of registration. If you choose the “Monthly Payment Plan”, an initial payment is due at the time of registration and auto payments are processed the first day of each month from September 1st through April 1st.

“When can I register my child for preschool classes?”

Open enrollment for preschool begins on May 1st. Families are encouraged to register without delay, as space is limited.

“Does my child need to be potty-trained?”

Children in the 2 ½-3 Year Old and 3-Year Old Preschool Programs are allowed to wear Pull-Ups®. Children in the 4 Year Old Pre-school Program must be fully potty-trained.
