

Addison All Star Summer Recreational Swim

Starting the week of July 13th – 17th of Addison All Star Summer program we will be adding recreational swim for participants of the program on both Thursday and Friday between 1 – 3 pm. The recreational swim will provide participants of Addison All Star Summer an opportunity for swim games, relay races and other swim activities with their friends and counselors. Swim equipment used during recreational swim will not be shared. We will assure that everyone can enjoy the water in a comfortable, safe setting. During recreational swim, the pool is carefully guarded by a certified lifeguard pool staff, while the trained counselors remain in the water with the campers. Your child will take a swim assessment on their first day of swimming at the program. The assessment is designed to gauge a child’s swimming skills and comfort level. If needed, Addison All Star Summer may use swim bands to designate areas of the pool your child may go. Participants will be bussed over from Community Rec Center to Centennial Club Fitness to use the indoor aquatic facility. Vehicles will be cleaned prior to and after each use as well as we ask participants and staff to wear facial masks to be worn while on the vehicle. Families who plan to bring their child on Thursday or Fridays during the remainder of Addison All Star Summer program will be asked questions about your child’s swim experience (please see below).
