1. Call to Order

a) 2020 Tax Levy Proposal – Executive Director Hermonson explained that we keep our levy under 5% in accordance with the state stature law. She reviewed some changes in our levy this year, one being social security because of the tax objections and noted that nothing has really changed year over year. They will budget for the CPI if a lower amount for the collected taxes is lower. She will send out the report with the detailed information.

Interim Superintendent of Finance, Elliott Becker gave an update on information received from the assessor's office. Discussion took place.

- c) Resolution 20-R-05 Approval of individuals designated to serve as delegate(s) to the annual Business Meeting of the Illinois Association of Park Districts Conference on January 30, 2021 Executive Director Hermonson noted that this is standard protocol every year for the annual IAPD conference. Approval will be at the November board meeting.

d) Commissioner Terms - President Angiulo asked commissioner Towns to explain the information. She explained that boards can pass a resolution or referendum to go from six to four-year terms as board members. She asked for opinions of the board members about this. Discussion took place with comments to consider changing it. It was suggested that further discussion is needed before a decision should be made to change the term amounts.
