## **Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures**

- A parent/guardian or other authorized individual must sign the participant in and out of camp each day. Proof of identification may be required for dropping off and picking up participants.
- **Early Drop Off is permitted.** Before Care begins at 7:00am. Supervision is not provided prior to 7:00am. Regular camp hours begin at 9:00am.
- Late Pick Up policy and fee structure. Children must be picked up at the appropriate time. Regular day camp ends at 4:00pm, A late pickup fee will be charged if your child is not picked up by 4:10pm. After camp care runs until 6:00pm, a late pickup fee will be charged if your child is not picked up by 6:10pm. The fee is \$1 for every minute you're late to pick up the child. The fee must be paid by the following business day before your child will be admitted to the program. Counselors will provide you with a late pick-up fee form.
