Free Lunch Program

In 2023 and 2024, free lunch and snacks were provided to all campers by the Northern Illinois Food Bank. We have applied to continue these services for our 2025 Summer Camp program and are waiting for confirmation of NIFB's continued support.

Child Care Assistance Program for Summer Campers

The Addison Park District accepts the Illinois Department of Human Services' Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) funding, which is administered by the YWCA of Metropolitan Chicago located in Addison. CCAP helps income-eligible parents pay for child care while they work or go to school.

The best way to screen for eligibility is by using the Illinois Department of Human Services Child Care Eligibility Calculator at: https://www.dhs.state.il.us/applications/ChildCareEligCalc/eligcalc.html

If the tool suggests your family qualifies for CCAP, you will need to complete a CCAP application by filling out the (paper) application. Stop by our office to pick up the 17-page application, fill it out, turn it back in to us, along with the required documents, and we will submit the paperwork to the YWCA on your family's behalf. After submission, it takes approximately 2 weeks to be notified of approval or denial of benefits and the amount of the co-pay if applicable.



Emergency Forms/Waivers: After registering your child online, you will receive an email with a request and link to create an ePACT account for your child (a separate request will be sent for each child.) Creating an account will allow you to share important information about your child, including emergency contact information, with the Addison Park District. This step must be completed before the child can start Summer Camp. Monthly calendars will be posted online at addisonparks.org, which will include Summer Camp's daily activities and the restaurants and meals that will be included in our Thursday Lunch Delivery program. Staff will adhere to all IDPH and CDC guidelines with safety being our top priority. All staff will have trainings focusing on health and safety standards, child wellness, behavior management, and be certified in CPR/1st Aid.
